Dear Exhibitor,

As we approach the 2017 Franklin County Fair, July 13-16, we welcome some of you back and look forward to new exhibitors.

This packet includes two forms that need to be signed and returned; application and liability form and forbidden booth items list. A non-refundable \$25.00 deposit is required to be made if the full amount cannot be sent with the forms. This non-refundable deposit holds your spot due to limited spaces. We offer electric on a first come first paid-in-full fee of \$25.00.

The price for a 10X10 spot is \$100.00. This also includes two season passes to use each day for gate access. Nonprofit organizations will pay a fee of \$25.00 for the 10X10 spot and receive one pass for gate access. If additional passes are needed for booth workers or family, they may be purchased at season ticket price. Additional passes may also be purchased at our ticket locations. Daily admission can be paid at the gates.

Each exhibitor will need to provide their own cover. We suggest that you bring something to weigh down your tent in case of questionable weather. Common items used are buckets filled with sand or rock, bags of kitty litter or salt, and cinder blocks.

You may set up Wednesday July 12<sup>th</sup> after 3pm or Thursday before 1pm. Vehicles are not allowed on the grounds within one hour of gates opening daily. A schedule of gate times are included in this information packet.

- HANDCUFFS
- KNUMCHUCKS
- KNIVES
- ELECTRONIC STUN-GUNS
- LASERLIGHTS-STROBE LIGHTS
- SILLY STRING
- MOUTH GLOW TUBES
- DRUG PARAPHERNALIA OF ANY KIND
- PERFORMANCE ENHANCING PILLS OR LOTIONS
- STINK BOMBS (INCLUDES ANYTHING THAT GIVES OFF AN OBNOXIOUS ORDER)
- CHEMICAL SPRAYS (INCLUDING MACE AND PEPPER SPRAY)
- OTHER SIMILAR ITEMS THAT MAY BE USED AS WEAPONS
- ANY OTHER ITEM DEEMED DANGEROUS, OFFENSIVE, LEWD, OR IN POOR TASTE AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE FAIR BOARD OR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT MAY BE BANNED AT ANYTIME DURING THE FAIR.

THE JUDGEMENT OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND FAIR BOARD IS FINAL ON THIS ISSUE.
